WHO IS THE DATA CONTROLLER

Personal data are collected by the Data Controller by means of registration and storage in our paper and IT databases.

Processing is based on the principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency, purpose and conservation limitation, data minimisation, accuracy, integrity and confidentiality and accountability.

WHICH PERSONAL DATA WE DO COLLECT

We collect these types of data:

- companies responsible for sending commercial communications by email;
